## GENERAL INFORMATION

This product is recommended for broadcast control of most annual grasses and certain broadleaf weeds. It should be applied to the soil surface prior to crop or weed emergence. The soil surface should be freshly worked and free of weed growth. The seed bed should be fine, firm and free of clods and trash.

Best results are obtained when moisture occurs within one week after application. High intensity or excessive rainfall or excessive irrigation after application may reduce control.

Use of this product in conjunction with the herbicides may result in injury to certain grasses and broadleaf weeds. If injury occurs, take appropriate measures to prevent further damage.

For best results, start at D.A.T. and end with water in furrow. Start early to minimize

## APPLICATION EQUIPMENT AND CALIBRATION

**Broadcast Treatment:** Broadcast treatments may be applied with a spreader.

**Band Treatment:** Band widths of 12 inches or greater are recommended. The amount of granules per acre required for each treatment is as follows:

Band width (inches)	Broadcast Rate (lb./ac.)	Band Rate (lb./ac.)
12"	1.0	0.5
18"	0.67	0.33
24"	0.44	0.22
36"	0.22	0.11

For example, if 200 pounds of granules are required for broadcast treatment and you want to treat a band 12 inches wide, then you would apply 100 pounds.
