Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals

**DANGER! CORROSIVE.
CAUSES EYE DAMAGE

HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED

Do not get on eyes or skin.
Wear goggles, face shield and rubber gloves when handling.

FIRST AID: IN CASE OF CONTACT Flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing including shoes before re-use. If irritation persists, consult a physician.

IF SWALLOWED drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.** Call a physician immediately.

Note to Physicians: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

Thoroughly wet surface and allow to remain wet for ten minutes.
