For control of the following hollow stem plant, follow the use instructions below:

#### Reed, Common (Phragmites australis)

Inject 5 ml per stem of a 50% solution, equal parts of this product and water, between second and third internode or into freshly cut stems.

**NOTE**: Based on the maximum annual use rate of glyphosate for these non-crop sites, the combined total for all treatments must not exceed 8 quarts of this product per acre. At 5 ml of a 50% solution per stem, 8 quarts should treat approximately 3,000 stems.

Read "LIMIT OF WARRANTY AND LIABILITY" in the label booklet for Aquamaster herbicide before using this product. Those terms apply to this supplemental labeling and, if those terms are not acceptable, return the product unopened at once.
