DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Nbroxane Technical should be added directly to the water in the solution makeup of the gelatin or dyes to make a concentration of 0.01 to 0.1% (0.1 ml to 1 ml/liter of solution).

Gelatin solutions should be used within a few days. The dye dispersion may be stored for several months.
