HOW TO CALIBRATE

- 1. Expedite application equipment should be calibrated prior to each use of this product.
- 2. Attached Expedite calibration flow cup to the Expedite equipment. Remove spray disc, if attached.
- 3. Connect the product container and prime the equipment to remove the trapped air. Priming must be done with the head of the lance held above the handle but below the level of the product container.
- 4. Lower the lance head with attached calibration cup to spraying position.
- 5. Depress the trigger with the power on. Collect the product for a measured period of time, such as 30 seconds. Cheel; the amount of product collected in the calibration sup.
- 6. Raise the lance tip above head level and deprets the trigger long enough to allow product to flow back into the lance.
- 7. Repeat until the correct volume is obtained.

HOW TO APPLY

Apply this product as a uniform spray over the foliage of undesirable vegetation. Use only Expedite application equipment when applying this product.

Before spraying, or during the calibration process, the lance must be primed to remove trapped air. To prime the lance, set the head setting to G+ and depress the trigger until all air is removed from the lance. Priming must be done with the head of the lance held above the handle but below the level of the product container.

To select general flow rate settings for applying this product, use the Expedite Set-N-Spray settings listed in the following application quide. The letters followed by a number (A0....E1) represent equipment settings for flow rates within the application range recommended for this product. If more precise equipment calibration is desired, use the Multi Flow* units listed below the Set-N-Spray settings in the following application guide. See the "HOW TO CALIBRATE" section of this label for specific calibration procedures.

A range of application rates are represented in the following application guide. Use the higher rate in the range on difficult-to-control species, perennials and mature weeds.

When the desired head setting is obtained, use the round spinner and adjust the spinner speed to obtain the correct swath width and apply product at the desired walking speed. Keep lance head moving at desired ground speed during application to avoid over application and turf injury.

HOW TO CALIBRATE

- 1. Determine the proper Multi Flow units required from the above application guide. The number of Multi Flow units required is where the swath width row intersects the walking speed column. For example, for a 1.5 mph walking speed and a 12" swath width, 7 to 11 Multi Flow units are recommended.
- 2. Prime the lance.
- 3. Remove the spray disc and attach the Expedite calibration flow cup.
- 4. For the initial calibration check, set the equipment within the range of Set-N-Spray settings listed in the application guide. Lower the lance head to the spraying position, depress the trigger for 30 seconds and compare the measured volume to the desired Multi Flow units.
- 5. If required, adjust the head setting and repeat the process until the desired Multi Flow units are obtained. To remove the product from the calibration cup, raise the lance above head level and depress the trigger long enough to allow the product to flow back into the lance.
- 6. When the desired head setting is obtained, remove the calibration cup and reattach the round spinner.

CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT

The Expedite application equipment must be cleaned after each use and prior to storage. Use Expedite cleaner to remove residues of this product.
