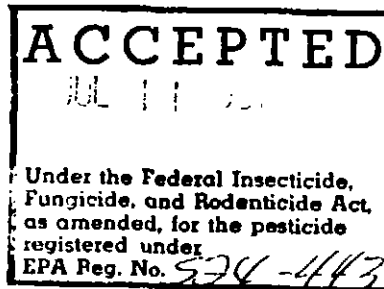

- Apply 1 qt per 5000 sq. ft. on the following established turfgrass lawns: Bahia, Bentgrass, Bluegrass, Bermudagrass, Centipede, Fescue, Ryegrass, St. Augustine, and dichondra lawns for control of crabgrass.

USE PRECAUTIONS: Do not reseed turfgrass lawns within four months after application. This product can be applied to dichondra lawns at the time of seeding or any time thereafter. Keep children and pets off treated lawns until grass is completely dry.

BACK PANEL CONT'D.

WHEN TO USE: Application of this product must precede emergence of weeds from the soil. Crabgrass will emerge from the soil 4 to 6 weeks before it is visible above the turfgrass. If crabgrass is visible above the soil, it is too late to apply Greensweep® Preemergent Crabgrass Preventer. Where germination of crabgrass extends into the late summer and early fall, a second application should be made 4 to 5 months after the initial application.

HOW TO APPLY:

- Make sure ON/OFF valve is in OFF position.
- Shake well before applying.
- Connect spray nozzle to hose.
- Turn on the water at the tap.
- When ready to treat, point in direction away from face and body and pull the tab toward the hose end connection. Turn the ON/OFF valve to the ON position. The water mixes automatically with Greensweep at the proper ratio.
- Walk and spray at a steady pace. Marks on the side of bottle indicate the number of square feet covered in 1,000's.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, foodstuffs, feed or seed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store this product in its original container and in a secured storage area. In case of SPILL or LEAK, soak up with paper towels and discard in trash. Protect from temperatures below 42°F. At temperatures below 42°F, product may crystallize. Crystals will dissolve at warm temperatures (60°F) without agitation.

DISPOSAL: To dispose of unused product, securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Emptied container retains vapor and product residue. Observe all labeled safeguards until container is discarded. Do not reuse empty container or sprayer assembly for other purposes. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
