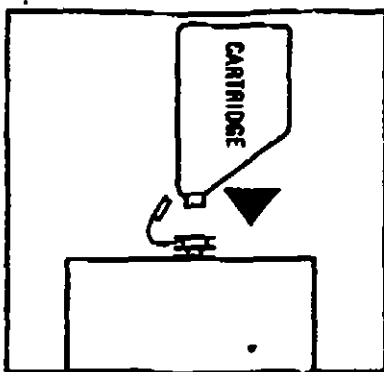

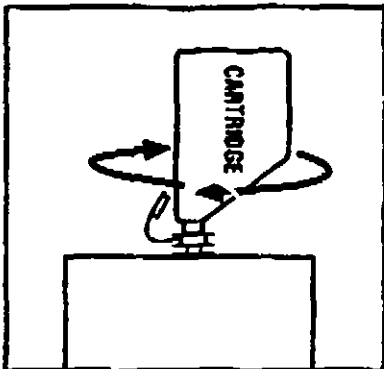

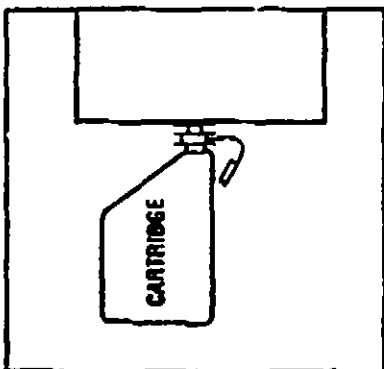
TO REFILL



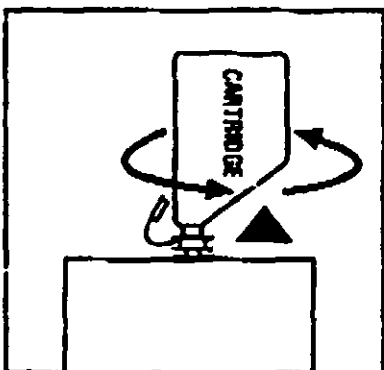
Align grooves of the Compact cartridge to ridges of the Big Five refill pack.



Twist the cartridge clockwise through 90° to lock the two containers and open valves.



Invert, ensuring the Big Five pack is uppermost and allow the cartridge to refill.



Unlock the packs by twisting anti-clockwise through 90° and disconnect.

Keep a cloth handy to wipe the nozzle of the refilled cartridge.

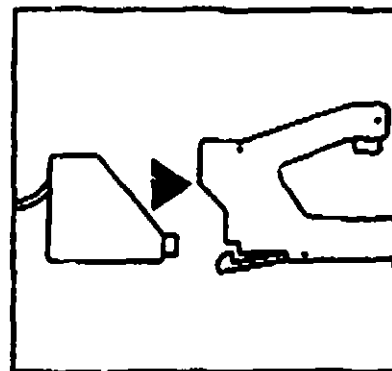
NB: Empty cartridges should only be refilled for one season.

Ensure cartridges are only refilled with the same herbicide as originally labelled.

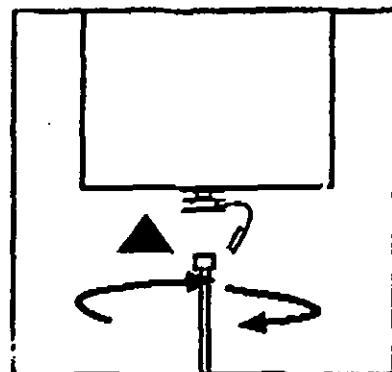

CONNECT

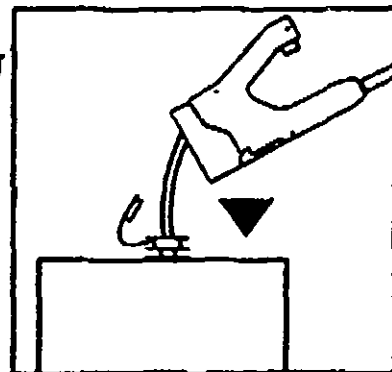


Insert Nomix Link-Up cassette into the Compact

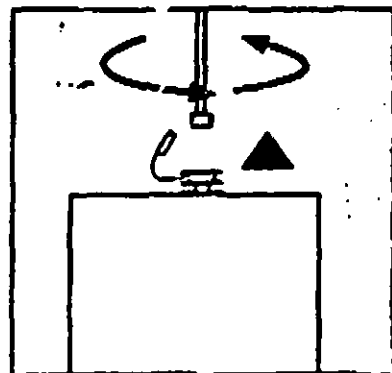


Insert Big Five into backpack. Connect to herbicide pack by aligning groove of pipe to ridges of Big Five and twist through 90° clockwise.

TO
DISCONNECT



Raise Compact above backpack. Depress Compact trigger to drain herbicide through lance and into Big Five



Unlock by twisting anti-clockwise through 90° and disconnect.
