DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in any manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of herbicide application.

AVOID CONTACT OF HERBICIDE WITH FOLIAGE, GREEN STEMS, EXPOSED NON-WOODY ROOTS OR FRUIT OF CROPS, DESIRABLE PLANTS AND TREES, BECAUSE SEVERE INJURY OR DESTRUCTION MAY RESULT.

Do not feed or graze treated areas for 8 weeks following application.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1.0 Wiper Applications

When applied as directed in the "SELECTIVE EQUIPMENT" section of the Round Original RT herbicide label, this product may be used for weed control in grasses grown for seed production.

Contact of the herbicide solution with desirable vegetation may result in damage or destruction. Applicators should be adjusted so that the wiper contact point is at least two (2) inches above the desirable vegetation.

Weeds should be a minimum of six (6) inches above the desirable vegetation. Better results may be obtained when more of the weed is exposed to the herbicide solution. Weeds not contacted by the herbicide solution will not be affected.

This may occur in dense clumps, severe infestations, or when height of weeds varies so that not all weeds are contacted. In these instances, repeat treatments may be necessary. Better results may be obtained if 2 applications are made in opposite directions.

2.0 Preemergence applications

This product may be applied postplant and preemergence to grasses grown for seed production. Applications **MUST** be made prior to the emergence of the crop to avoid crop injury.

See the "WEEDS CONTROLLED" section of the Roundup Original RT herbicide label for specific rate recommendations and the "APPLICATION EQUIPMENT AND TECHNIQUES" section for application recommendations.

3.0 Spot Treatments

When applied as directed under the conditions described, Roundup Original RT herbicide will control grass and broadleaf weeds listed in the Roundup Original RT herbicide label booklet.

Use a 1 to 5 percent solution of Roundup Original RT herbicide on a volume to volume basis with water. See the "SELECTIVE EQUIPMENT" section for additional application recommendations.

Apply this product prior to heading of grasses. Do not treat more than 10 percent of the total field to be harvested. The crop receiving the spray in the treated area will be killed. Take care to avoid drift or spray outside the target area for the same reason.

4.0 Creating Rows in Annual Ryegrass

Roundup Original RT herbicide may be used to create rows in annual ryegrass stands.

Use 18 to 32 fluid ounces of this product per acre mixed with water. Use the higher rate when the ryegrass is greater than 6 inches in height.

Set nozzle heights to allow the establishment of the desired row spacing while preventing spray droplets, spray fines, or drift to contact the ryegrass plants not treated. Use of low pressure nozzles, or drop nozzles designed to target the application over a narrow band are recommended.

Grower assumes all responsibility for crop losses from misapplication.
