ROTATIONAL CROP GUIDELINES

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in any manner inconsistent with its labeling. This label must be in the possession of the user at the time of application.

All applications of Permit herbicide must be according to label directions. The crops listed on this supplemental label may be planted at the specified time intervals after the most recent application of Permit herbicide. Rotational crop intervals are based on the risk of injury to the rotational crop.

When applying labeled combinations of Permit herbicide and other herbicides, read all other product labels referred to for the recommended mixture and follow all precautions and restrictions. When another herbicide is applied in combination with Permit herbicide, always follow the crop rotational restrictions of the label with the longest time interval from the time of the most recent application.

ROTATIONAL CROP INFORMATION

Labeled Crops may be planted at specified time intervals following application of approved rates of Permit herbicide. Use the time intervals listed below to determine the required time interval before planting.
