Broadcast Spray. This product may be applied as an over-the-top broadcast spray to control labeled weeds prior to the harvest of peas, lentils, and chick peas. Apply up to 1 quart in 3 to 20 gallons of water per acre at the hard dough stage of the grain (30% grain moisture or less). Either ground broadcast or aerial applications may be made.

Spot Treatments. This product may be applied as a spot treatment to control troublesome weeds such as Canada Thistle, quackgrass, and milkweed in peas, lentils, and chick peas. Apply 2 - 3 quarts in 10 - 20 gallons of water through ground spray equipment or use a 2% solution in a hand-held sprayer. For best results, applications should be made at or beyond the bud stage of growth. The crop receiving spray in treated areas will be killed.

PRECAUTIONS, RESTRICTIONS:

Apply at least 7 days before harvest. Only one application per year may be made; do not combine spot treatments with a preharvest broadcast spray on the same crop area. No more than 10% of the total field area may be treated at rates above 1 quart per acre (spot treatment). Employ at least a 30-day plant-back interval between treatment and replanting for any crop not listed in the Roundup Ultra herbicide label. Do not make broadcast preharvest applications to crops grown for seed, as a reduction in germination or vigor may result. Do not feed treated vines and hay from these crops to livestock.

Use nozzles that emit medium to large-sized droplets to minimize drift. The likelihood of drift occurring from the use of this product increases when winds are gusty, as wind velocity increases, when wind direction is constantly changing, or when there are other meteorological conditions that favor spray drift. Extreme care must be used when applying this product to avoid injury to desirable plants and crops.

Read the "Limit of Warranty and Liability" in the label booklet for Roundup Ultra herbicide before using. These terms apply to this supplemental labeling and if these terms are not acceptable, return the product unopened at once.
