Dear Ms. Fee-White:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment.

- 1) Revise "Causes eye irritation" to "Causes moderate eye irritation."
- 2) Revise "Avoid contact with skin eyes or clothing" to "Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing."
- 3) Add "/PPE" after "Remove clothing" in the second bullet of the User Safety Recommendations
- 4) In the Ingredient Statement, add the Total of 100% back to the label.

Submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling incorporating the above changes before you release the product for shipment. Amended labeling will supercede all previously accepted ones.
