

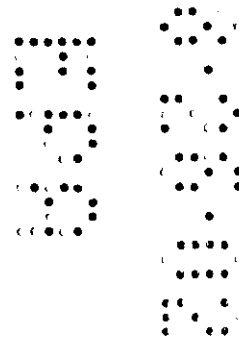

Dear Mr. Tompkins:

Enclosed for your files are three copies of a Final Printed Supplemental Label for Roundup UltraMAX herbicide for weed control in vegetables and strawberries using selective equipment.

On 10-Dec-2001, the Agency approved a Master Label for all uses registered under EPA Reg. No. 524-454. That approval included these uses. Because labels for Roundup UltraMAX herbicide were already in the marketplace, the newly approved uses must be communicated by supplemental label. We anticipate that any future printing of the booklet will include all relevant uses from the 10-Dec text.

The enclosed label contains the 10-Dec approved label text pertaining to selective equipment as it applies to vegetables and strawberries. Preplant and preemergent uses are already part of the printed booklet text.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Post-directed hooded sprayers and wiper equipment capable of preventing all crop contact with herbicide solutions may be used in mulched or unmulched row middles after crop establishment. Refer to the "SELECTIVE EQUIPMENT" part of the "APPLICATION EQUIPMENT AND TECHNIQUES" section of the label booklet for this product for essential precautions when using hooded sprayers or wipers to avoid crop injury caused by leakage of spray mists or dripping onto crops. Crop injury is possible with these applications and shall be the sole responsibility of the applicator.

TYPES OF APPLICATIONS: Hooded Sprayers in row-middles, Shielded Sprayers in row-middles or Wiper Applicators in row-middles.

PRECAUTIONS, RESTRICTIONS: Avoid contact of herbicide with foliage, green shoots or stems, bark, exposed roots (including those emerging from plastic mulch), or fruit of crops because severe injury or destruction may result.
