# MILL-O-CIDE.

CONTACT INSECTICIDE  
FOR FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS

A highly concentrated insecticide for use in schools, hospitals, motels, hotels, restaurants, cafeterias, bakeries, dairies, bottling plants, breweries, super markets, canning factories, mills and other establishments where food is processed, stored or served. Kills flies, roaches, silverfish, mosquitoes. Kills the accessible stages of weevils, flour moths, flour beetles, and certain other insects.

**DIRECTIONS**  
Hold dispenser upright. Point valve opening away from face. **SPRAY ONLY 3 SECONDS** for each 1000 cubic feet of space. Also spot spray under and around all equipment, and into all cracks, crevices and corners. Keep sprayed area closed for 10 to 15 minutes following treatment. Sweep up and dispose of fallen insects. Repeat application as often as necessary.

### CAUTION

**CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE.** Do not puncture or throw into fire. Do not store in direct sunlight or where temperature exceeds 120°F. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Do not spray into or on food products or materials. Cooking vessels and other food equipment should be covered or closed before spraying. Do not spray in areas where food processing operation is in progress. Do not remain in inclosed treated area, and ventilate before reuse.
