D-D is effective in disinfecting against Tubercle Bacilli, Salmonella typhosa, Staphylococcus aureus, Shigella paradysenteriae, Salmonella schottmuelleri, Escherichia coli, Streptococcus pyogenes, Pseudomonas aeruginosa, Salmonella choleraesuis and Trichophyton interdigitale. D-D also controls mildew (mold or fungi).

D-D is recommended for use on toilet seats, urinals, lavatories, bathtubs, shower stalls, bed frames, wheel chairs, linen carts, hampers, lockers, telephones, door knobs, refuse cans, physical therapy equipment and athletic equipment. D-D has a special odor neutralizer which suppresses odors and leaves any room filled with a pleasant scent rather than a strong disinfectant odor.

DIRECTIONS

For Disinfecting: After object has been thoroughly cleaned, spray surface until wet from a distance of 6 to 8 inches.

For Deodorizing: Hold dispenser upright. Point valve opening away from face. Spray into air towards center of room for 3 to 4 seconds.

For Mildew: Spray a thoroughly clean surface until wet. Repeat application once a week for continued control.

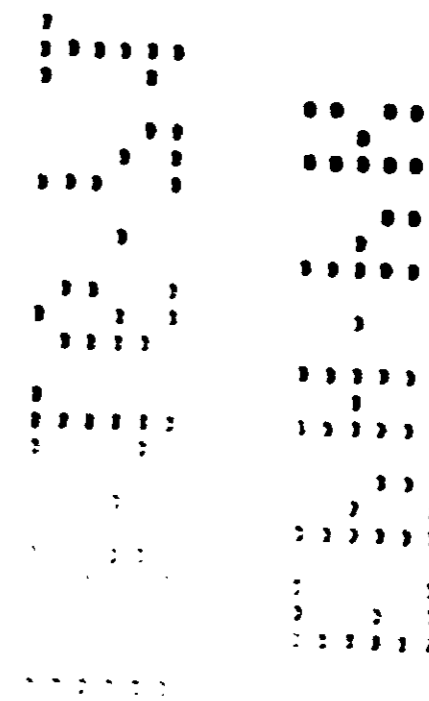
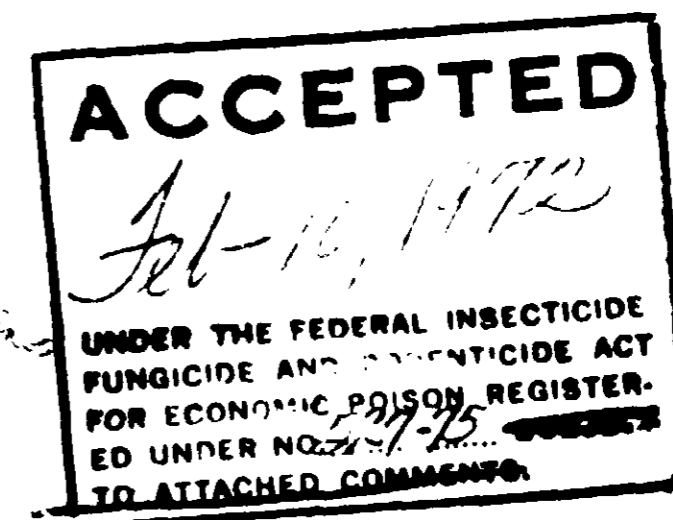
WARNING— Avoid contact with eyes.

DISINFECTANT DEODORANT GERMICIDE

This product is a powerful disinfectant, germicide and deodorant with a pleasant mint odor. It is broad spectrum in its microbiological activity, effective against gram positive and gram negative bacteria, including Salmonella, Choleraesuis, Staphylococcus Aureus and Streptococcus Pyogenes.

It is designed for use in general household use, office buildings, industrial plants, food industries, restaurants, gymnasiums, locker rooms, public rest rooms, hotels and motels. When used as a deodorant, the pleasant aroma is noticeable from 1 to 3 hours after use. Can be used for general disinfecting and deodorizing of floors, walls, sinks, bathroom areas, toilets, urinals, refrigerators, telephones, stoves, garbage cans, basements, rubber goods, scissors and razors.

DIRECTIONS

REGULAR CLEANING AND SANITIZING: Use 1 ounce to a gallon of water.

GENERAL DISINFECTING: Remove all filth and dirt, then use a solution of 1 1/4 ounces of Disinfectant to each gallon of water.

FLOORS: When mopping or scrubbing, use 1 1/4 ounces of Disinfectant to each gallon of water. May be used in the rinse water as well, providing a pleasant mint scented deodorizer.

GARBAGE RECEPTACLES: To aid in inhibiting the growth of bacteria, sprinkle with a solution of 2 ounces to a gallon of water. Rinse the empty can with some of the solution and leave the wash in the can.

TO AID IN THE SANITARY DISPOSAL OF URINE AND FECES: Use 2 ounces of Disinfectant to 1 gallon of water.

SICKROOM: Disinfecting of floors, walls, bed frames -- Use 2 oz. per gallon. For bed clothes and clothing soak in a solution of 2 oz. per gallon before laundering. For bed pans, and utensils use 2 oz. per gallon and rinse thoroughly with potable water.

TOILET ROOMS, WATER CLOSETS AND URINALS: Wash the toilet bowls and urinals regularly with a solution of 2 oz. Disinfectant to a gallon of water leaving the solutions in the bowl as long as possible. Scrub the floor and seat with this solution. For toilet bowls, remove bowl water before disinfecting.

If a Staphylocidal product is required, use 2 oz. of the disinfectant to a gallon of water.

WARNING: Causes skin and severe eye irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Wash empty container thoroughly with water and detergent. Discard in a safe place.

DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting, drink plenty of water and call a physician immediately.
