MILL-O-CIDE 300 is a high kill fly, wasp, bumble bee, house fly, and other insecticide for use in food establishments. It is a contact insecticide that kills insects on contact. It is used in food processing plants, restaurants, hotels, and other establishments where food is processed or stored. When used as directed, this product will kill accessible house flies, bumble bees, wasps, and other insects on contact.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Irritant to eyes, throat, and skin. Contains petroleum distillate. Avoid breathing vapors or spraying in respiratory areas. Use with adequate ventilation. Avoid contact with skin or eyes.
