ACTIVE INGREDIENTS — n-Alkyl (60% C₁₁, 30% C₁₂, 5% C₁₃, 5% C₁₄) dimethyl benzyl ammonium chlorides, 7.0%; Tetrasodium ethylene diamine tetraacetate, 0.50%; Sodium carbonate, 3.0%;

INERT INGREDIENTS — 89.5%

MIDLAND Detergent-Sanitizer is a quaternary ammonium germicide in combination with synthetic detergents for use in supermarkets and meat packing plants. It is designed for use in conjunction with the Kleen-King High Pressure Washer to provide "liquid brush" cleaning and sanitizing power. This product is also effective when used in manual cleaning operations.

DIRECTIONS

Use product to clean and sanitize meat cases, tables, saws, grinders, coolers, cleavers, trays, racks, carts, and all self-service cases.

All surfaces having direct contact with raw meat or unwrapped foods should be thoroughly rinsed with potable water before reuse.

In making solution, first partially fill container with water, then add Detergent-Sanitizer Concentrate.

FOR GENERAL CLEANING AND SANITIZING: Use 2 ounces per gallon water.

FOR USE IN THE KLEEN-KING High Pressure Washer: follow chart below.

When metering ratio is set at:	Gallons of Detergent-Sanitizer per 5 gallons of solution:
30 to 1	1 1/2
20 to 1	1
15 to 1	3/4
10 to 1	1/2
5 to 1	1/4
