The amendment (deletion of Cold Disinfection and label update) referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, has been reviewed by the Agency and found to be acceptable, provided that you:

1. Enlarge the type size of the Child Hazard Warning Statement: "Keep Out Of Reach Of Children", from 8 Pt. to 10 Pt. Bodoni Bold.

2. Include a complete Spanish translation of the labeling text since you intend to provide additional text in this language. The draft labels you submitted did not include a Spanish translation of the Front Panel.

3. Submit five (5) copies of the revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOOD PROCESSING EQUIPMENT: For sanitization of previously cleaned food processing equipment and food utensils, dilute 1 ounce BYTECH TEN-FIFTY per 4 gallons of water to provide 200 ppm of active quaternary. Thoroughly wet all surfaces for at least 60 seconds. Drain and let air dry. At this level, no potable water rinse is required.

BYTECH TEN-FIFTY fulfills the criteria of Appendix F, the Grade A Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1965 recommendations of the U.S. Public Health Service in waters up to 750 ppm of hardness calculated as CaCO₃, when tested by the AOAC Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizers Official Method.

DAIRIES: To sanitize dairy equipment, first clean and rinse the equipment thoroughly. Then, apply sanitizing solution containing 1 ounce BYTECH TEN-FIFTY to 4 gallons of water (200 ppm) for at least 60 seconds. Remove and let air dry. Prepare a fresh solution daily or more frequently as soil is apparent. At this level, no potable water rinse is required. Follow recommendations of local Health Board.

HOSPITALS, NURSING HOMES, INSTITUTIONS

SANITIZING: For sanitizing previously cleaned floors, walls and inanimate hard surfaces, dilute 1 ounce BYTECH TEN-FIFTY to 4 gallons of water.

DISINFECTION: For general disinfection of previously cleaned floors, walls and inanimate hard surfaces, dilute 3 ounces BYTECH TEN-FIFTY to 5 gallons of water.
