PENTA TREAT READY TO USE

USES: For open tank dip treatment of lumber, timber, posts, poles and other forest products to control decay and attack by termites. Protects wood against blue stain, mold, mildew, borers and lyctus (powder post) beetles.

APPLICATION: Dipping - Most effective where deep penetration and absorption are required.

Lumber for steps, sills, etc. should be soaked for at least 12 hours. Posts and poles should be barked and air dried and then soaked for 24 to 48 hours.

BRUSHING: Two heavy applications recommended where wood is to be in contact with ground. On end grain make several extra applications.

COVERAGE: Dipping - 5 to 10 gallons per 1000 board feet. One gallon will treat 4-10 hardwood posts 3 inches in diameter full length. Brush or spray - one gallon covers 200 square feet.

TERMITE CONTROL: Spray or soak the soil which has been removed from around the foundation of the building to a depth of 30 inches, using one gallon of Penta Treat Ready to Use per linear foot of trench. Grass, trees or flowers within three feet of the trench should be removed or protected from the treated soil by tar paper or heavy kraft paper. Replace the treated dirt, respraying at 6-inch intervals as the earth is replaced. Treat wood at point of contact with masonry surfaces and replace damaged sills with new Penta treated wood. Do not spray on plants. For best results wood should be treated prior to use in construction.
