


**DIRECTIONS: Moles**—Locate main runways by either rolling turf or tamping the runways. Runways that are opened within 24 hours are the main runways. At intervals of 8 to 10 feet, insert a probing stick and drop in 4 or 5 pellets. Close the openings by covering with a piece of sod, a stone or other means so as to disturb the tunnel as little as possible, yet seal out the light.

**POCKET GOPHERS:** With the aid of a long handled spoon, remove a soft earth plug leading underground at a freshly thrownout mound of soil. Using the long handled spoon, introduce the bait, 4 or 5 pellets, as far down as possible. Close opening to the surface, being careful not to allow loose dirt to cover the bait.

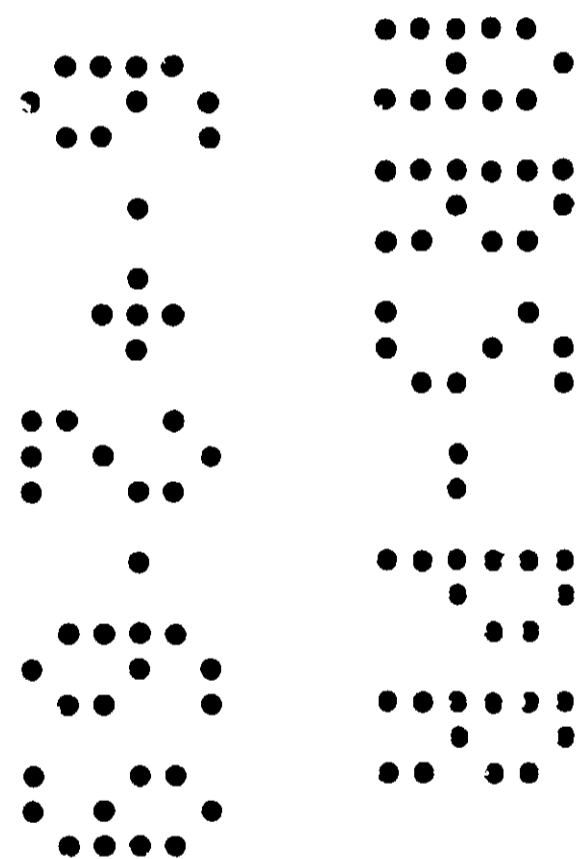
