1. Feed approximately 6 oz. of block per 1000 pound animal daily. FS PASTURE BLOCK WITH RABON may be fed up to slaughter and to lactating dairy cows without withholding the milk from market during or after treatment.
2. Place one block per five head of cattle.
3. Provide blocks where animals congregate.
4. Feed blocks continuously, never allow animals to run out. Add an additional block when each block has been one-half consumed.
5. Animals should not be starved for minerals before initiation of the FS PASTURE BLOCK WITH RABON program, but omit all salt from other feed after the program is started. Do not feed free choice sources of salt or minerals containing salt in any form.
6. When starting a feeding program during the fly season, it may be necessary to use other measures to reduce the population of existing adult flies. This product is not effective against existing adult flies. Supplemental fly control measures may be needed in and around cattle lots and buildings to control adult flies and stable flies which can breed not only in cattle manure but in other decaying vegetable matter or silage on the premises.
7. In order to achieve optimum fly control, FS PASTURE BLOCK WITH RABON should be used in conjunction with good management and sanitation practices.
