DIRECTIONS

TERMITES—Dilute concentrated "CHLORPAX" at the ratio of 1 pint to 5 gallons of water to yield a 2% water emulsion. Before proceeding with treatment, remove all waste wood in sight around building. For buildings having basements or crawl spaces, dig a trench along the outside of the foundation walls. In brick, hollow block, or concrete foundations dig a trench to, but not below, the footing. Trench same with diluted "CHLORPAX" using one gallon per lineal foot. Then trench is refilled, treat the soil at the rate of 4 gallons per 10 lineal feet. A trench 3 feet deep would require 12 gallons per 10 lineal feet. The purpose is to establish a treated soil barrier which will prevent termites from entering or leaving building without passing through poisoned ground. Other critical areas may also require treatment. It is suggested that you consult the State Extension Service for advice.

For effective and extended control, structural alterations and repairs are most essential as explained in U.S. Dept. of Agr. Farmers Bulletin #1911. Regardless of all preventative measures a yearly check-up is of importance.

WIREWORMS, JAPANESE BEETLE GRUBS, WHITE GRUBS, WHITE FRINGE BEETLE GRUBS, EUROPEAN CHAFER GRUBS—For 1 year control or initial kill, use 1½ to 2 quarts of this concentrate in 100 gallons of water per acre (2½ to 4 pounds of CHLORDANE). For more lasting control (two to three years) apply 1½ gallons of this concentrate in 100 gallons water per acre (10 pounds CHLORDANE). Apply to surface of soil before seeding or transplanting ornamental or grass. In case of lawns, apply to surface of grass. It is recommended that 100 gallons of water be minimum amount to apply. Keep children and pets off treated areas until the insecticide has been washed into the soil, the soil and the treated areas have dried completely. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed.

ANTS AND CHIGGERS—Use 9.3-13.1 ounces of this concentrate per 5000 square feet in 10 gallons of water (equivalent to 5-7 pounds of technical Chlordane/acre). Apply to ant nests, trying to hit as many insects as possible. If properly applied to uniform areas, Chlordane will remain effective for several months. For chiggers apply to grassy areas which these pests infest.

CHINCH BUGS ON LAWNS—This concentrate applied at rate of 1½ quarts per 100 gallons of water (2½ pounds CHLORDANE) per acre will control both adult and immature chinch bugs for a period of 1 to 2 months.

MOSQUITOS—Dilute "CHLORPAX" at 1 pint to 5 gals. water for 2% emulsion using 1 gal. emulsion/acre in favorable breeding places, such as ponds, marshes. This treatment will control early small wigglers or larvae. To reach emerged adult mosquito, it is commendable to treat grass foliage and other convenient hiding places using 5 gallons of 2% solution per acre. Treatment of shallow fish-bearing waters at recommended application rates will kill fish.
