Subject: Label Amendment for RED: 2,4-D
Scotts Lawn Weed Control
EPA Registration Number 538-9

The product referred to above is in compliance with 2,4-D RED and is amended under the RED provided that you:

1. Under the Environmental Hazards section of the label, delete the text "except as noted on appropriate labels." In addition, correct the typographical error in the fourth sentence "Do not contaminate **water** when disposing of equipment washwaters."
2. The following statements must be included under the "General Precautions/Restrictions" section of the label:

"Do not exceed 2 applications per year."

Also add the statement "For use on home lawns only" or "Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes" to the label.


3. Under First Aid, add a phone number for emergency medical treatment information to the label.
4. Under Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals, add the statement "Wear long sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes and socks."
5. Under General Precautions/Restrictions heading, change statement to read "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application."

6. Add User Safety Recommendations to the label, stating “User should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. User should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Users should remove PPE immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.”
7. Under Storage and Disposal, change bullets to read “Pesticide Storage” and “Pesticide Disposal”. Also, directly under the heading of Storage and Disposal, add the statement “Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.” The homeowner Storage and Disposal text appearing on Page 2 of the label must be deleted for this occupational use product.
8. Under the What to expect section, change the final statement to read “If this happens, please forward specimens so **Scotts** can identify them and advise further.” Delete the statement “After weeds may be resistant to control”, due to it not being clear.
9. Under Tips on Spreading with Scotts Spreaders, change third bullet statement to read “Overlay wheels to **ensure** uniform feeding”.
10. Under the heading [Optional Florida Environmental statement], change the third statement to read “Only apply this product to your lawn, and sweep any product that lands on the driveway, sidewalk or street, back onto your lawn.”
11. Please note: Final product reregistration cannot be considered until after all active ingredients in this product are eligible for reregistration.
12. Add the following statements to the labeling: Use of this product in certain portions of California, Oregon and Washington is subject to the January 22, 2004 Order for injunctive relief in Washington Toxics Coalition, et al. v. EPA, C01-0132C, (W.D. WA). For further information, please refer to EPA Web Site: <http://www.epa.gov/espp>.
