
The proposed subject amendments to the registration of "Scotts Bonus S" have been reviewed and were found unacceptable as a "Notification" under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended; however, it has been reviewed as an amendment of the registration; and was found acceptable provided that you:

1. As 4 optional formatting of the "Directions for Use" Section of the proposed labeling does not differ, format with the simple headings: Where To Apply, When To Apply, Use Precautions, Use Restrictions. Do not mix directions for where to apply with "restrictions" of use. All "do not statements" are considered as restrictions. Example: Revise the claim "Okay to apply in Florida, however.", to read: "May be applied to centipede or carpetgrass lawns during the period of winter dormancy between October 15 and March 15 in Florida." under the heading "Where To Apply".
2. Correct the typographic error by deleting the "F" as written FApply" on page 7,

2. Revise all labeling by deleting the use of the word. "recommended" in the "Directions For Use" sections, such that it is not implied that this Agency is responsible for such claims. As an example, on page 20 revise: "Recommended Annual Feeding/Lawn Care Program" to read: "Annual Feeding/Lawn Care Program".
3. On page 22, you must use your company name on all the product's "Guarantees", not the name of the product. such as "Expert Gardener®"
4. Revised labeling must include a copy showing changes highlighted in yellow or described as attachment to EPA Form 8570-1. Revisions of accepted labeling must be clearly identified and explained. Highlighting must be in yellow, **green** and darker colors are not copied electronically.
5. Resubmit 3 copies of the revised Master Label for EPA Acceptance Stamping. Submit revised labeling prior to shipping this pesticide product under the revised labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, this registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA, section 6(e). Your release for shipment of this product under the revised labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

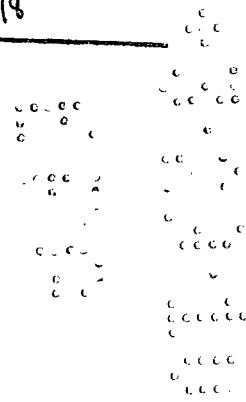
