 Prevents or controls fungus activity. Control pink and gray snow mold (Dothidea spp.).

For use on green, moss and algae:
 For the prevention of winter death, apply at the NORMAL RATE in November or December prior to the first snow. Apply two repeat treatments at approximately 4-6 week intervals whenever the ground is free of snow.

In control or avoid severe infestations or when heavy disease is anticipated, use the DOUBLE RATE.

Foliage may be either wet or dry when making application. On wet grass, rinse surface lightly after application to avoid pick up on shoes, golf balls or maintenance equipment.

Do not concentrate food or feedstuffs. Groundskeeper/maintenance personnel may not reenter treated areas within 24 hours following application unless shoes of reenter and gloves are worn.

Do not reuse treated area with crops other than those with registered Turf uses.

Storage and disposal:
STORAGE: Store in a clean, dry place. Recast covered bag by holding top down and inverting.
