To control chinchbugs, also billbugs, mole crickets, night crawlers - apply at double rate whenever active

Insects are more likely to cause problems in periods of hot, dry weather

for grass or dichondra lawns

FOR USE ON TURFGRASSES OR DICHONDRA

Foliage may be either moist or dry when making application.

Treatments for insects in the soil can be made any season. Rain or watering-in after application hastens action.

Treatments for surface-active insects should be made whenever they are active, but when the outlook is for no rain and watering, mowing or heavy traffic can be withheld at least 24 hours. The exception is chinchbug control—prompt watering is helpful.

This product is not for control of chinchbugs in the deep south from Florida to Texas.
