APPENDIX

(RETAIL, GRANULAR)

The following changes have been made to the attached product label for a product containing 2,4-D. The basis for these revisions were for a granular product sold to homeowners for residential use.

We have added the following statements to the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section of the label.

"When using this product, wear long sleeved shirt, long pants, socks and shoes."

"After using this product, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water."

"Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment areas until spray has dried or dust has settled."

We have added the following statements to the Directions For Use to satisfy our requirements to state the appropriate application rate for each product and limit the number of applications per year.

"This product applies (1.5 or 2.0 depending on product) pounds of 2,4—D per acre per application. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is two per year two per year."

- DO apply in spring (between second and fifth mowing) at regular rate to prevent crabgrass and to control actively growing weeds (listed above). Apply at Scotts Spreader (Standard, Automatic or Precision Flow Control Model) setting 6 3/4 (Treats 5.000 sq ft) In Colorado apply at setting 7 (treats 4,500 sq ft)
- DO apply in <u>fall</u> (September-October) or in the spring (between the second and fifth mowing) at heavy rate to prevent barnyardgrass and foxtail. In addition to crabgrass. The heavy rate application also controls. actively growing weeds (listed above).

- DON'T use this product to control crabgrass or other wild grasses already up and growing. Scotts recommends SUMMER CRABGRASS CONTROL to control actively growing crabgrass.
- DON'T expect control of dandelions overnight. A month of good growing weather may be required for complete control.
