For prevention of dollarspot, copper spot and brownpatch, apply to moist or dry foliage at the normal rate when disease activity is noted or suspected and repeat at 2 to 3 week intervals. Brownpatch control may require more frequent treatments under conditions especially favorable to disease activity.

To arrest these diseases, apply at the double rate and follow with the normal rate preventative program.
