The label labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section (3) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) is acceptable provided you make the following change:

Page 3 – Directions for Use

In an earlier revision, removal was requested for the "Not for homeowner use" statement. Such "Not for" statements are not enforceable by the Agency. The directions for use are to be explicit as to who, and what the product labeling is designated for. There are additional "Not for" and/or "Not" statements throughout this section that are requested for revision.

Page 8 – Precautionary Statements:

Your draft labeling indicates that you are using bold italic text to indicate which language belongs to the gold course product and which belongs to the retail (home use) product. Add language in bold italics indicating that everything between the bold italic "End of Retail Section" and "Optional Information for Retail Product" belongs to both label types.

Page 8- First Aid: Place inside of text box

Page 8: User Safety Recommendations: Format with bulleted statements

Page 9: Questions/Information For Retail Product

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance. Directions for use

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application.

Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

Keep children and pets off treated areas until material has been washed off the foliage and the area is completely dry. Do not feed clippings from treated turf to livestock and poultry. Do not contaminate feed or foodstuffs.

Prevents or arrests the turfgrass diseases brown patch, dollar spot and copper spot. In Washington, Oregon and California only, prevents or arrests pink snow mold (Fusarium patch).

Not a control for leaf spot or gray snow mold on turf.

Not a season long (all winter) control of snow mold unless applied on a 2 to 3 week application program.

TURF

For prevention of dollar spot*, copper spot and brown patch, apply to dry or moist foliage at the PREVENTIVE RATE when disease activity is noted or suspected and repeat at 2 to 3 week intervals. During conditions that favor disease activity such as humidity and high temperatures, brown patch control may require 2-week treatments intervals.

To avoid product pickup, lightly irrigate treated areas soon after application.

*If dollar spot control is not effective following the use of this product according to label directions, a thiophanate-methyl or benomyl tolerant strain of fungi may be present. Consult your ProTurf Tech Rep as consideration should be given to prompt use of other suitable ProTurf fungicides.

For prevention of pink snow mold, apply at the PREVENTIVE RATE to dry foliage when disease activity is anticipated. Repeat at 2 to 3 week interval.

For suppression of pink snow mold in areas where snow cover occurs, apply to dry foliage at the CURATIVE RATE prior to the first snow. Repeat in mid-winter when turf is free of snow and again immediately after the final snow melts in the spring.

Precautions

Allow one week between the application of this and other turf control products except where severe insect or disease attack requires immediate treatment.

Do not apply by hand or hand-held spreader.

When to use:

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift. Keep people and pets out of the area during application.

Do not enter or allow others to enter the treated areas until dusts have settled.

Prevention

- Apply to dry or moist foliage at the PREVENTIVE RATE when disease activity is noted or suspected.
- Repeat at 2 to 3 week intervals. During periods of high day and night temperature and humidity, 2 week treatment interval may needed to achieve best brown patch control.
- For cure of these diseases when symptoms indicate advanced stages, apply at the NORMAL RATE (CURATIVE) and follow with the PREVENTIVE RATE within 2 3 weeks.

Suppressing turfgrass diseases

- Apply to dry foliage at the NORMAL RATE (CURATIVE) every 30 days (beginning in late spring to early summer).
- Water-in immediately after application and keep turf from becoming drought stressed by watering (1 inch) weekly.
- Three to four applications may be necessary for season-long suppression.

Suppressing pink snow mold [Optional – only to be used when pink snow mold is listed on label]

- Apply to dry foliage at the CURATIVE RATE prior to the first snow.
- Repeat in mid-winter when turf is free of snow and again after the final snow melts in the spring.

How to use:

Do not apply by hand or with hand-held rotary spreader. Apply with a drop-type spreader.
 For best results with a rotary spreader, apply during a calm period of the day. If necessary to

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apply when a breeze is blowing, move in the direction of the wind to prevent material from blowing toward the operator.

- Allow one week between the application of this and other control products. (This guideline
 may be relaxed where a severe insect or disease attack requires immediate treatment).
- Maximum number of applications is four per year.
- It is not necessary to water in immediately. However, water is required before product will be activated.
- Do not apply more than 2.7 lb Systemic Fungicide per 1000 sq ft. of turf.
