Your Application Dated October 26, 1982

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

It is noted that you have not complied with our letters of August 8 and September 9, 1979 regarding the necessary addition of a Statement of Practical Treatment (first aid) section.

1. A Statement of Practical Treatment must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement, however, if your toxicological data suggests otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If Inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on Skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in Eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

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This required text should be added to the text of the labeling accepted this date. If actual printing on the product bags has not yet occurred, this change should be made prior to release for marketing under the amended labeling. If bags have already been printed, please add the required section prior to additional printing. Please submit 5 copies of the revised labeling as soon as it becomes available.
