Directions for use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DO apply when insect activity or damage (chewed or browned leaves) is first observed in the lawn.

NOTE: For Grub Control:

Northern States—The most likely period for grubs is late July through early October but in some cases grubs are active in the spring. An application for spring grub activity requires a repeat summer-early fall application for effective control.

Southern States—Apply during July-August. A second application may be needed six weeks later. Applications made later in the year, when grubs are more mature, are less effective.

For chinch bugs start treatments when daily high temperatures are 80° or above and repeat at 6 week intervals.

For mole crickets, the time to apply is in May to July.

DO apply when lawn is dry. For mole crickets and white grubs, water thoroughly and let lawn dry, then apply product.

DO water lawn after application to wash granules from the lawn foliage. If treating for grubs or

mole crickets, water thoroughly so that active ingredients will be carried into the rootzone. DO make a repeat application if there are signs of renewed insect activity. (Normally, application gives effective control for approximately 6 weeks.)

DO apply at Scotts Spreader (Standard, Automatic or Precision Flow Control Model) setting: 5/4 (treats 5,000 sq ft)

DON'T treat just the browned areas of lawn. To prevent further damage, treat entire lawn.

DON'T use any other lawn control product for at least one week after application.

DON'T allow traffic on lawn after application until granules are watered off lawn foliage and lawn has dried.

DON'T use on fruit or vegetable plantings.

DON'T apply with a rotary-type spreader.
