WHEN TO USE

For control of insect damage apply when activity is first observed or when chewed or brown grass indicates damage from these insects. Repeat at signs of renewed insect activity.

For grub control, make an application when damage is first noticed. Grub activity and damage is most likely from late July thru early October, but can also occur in the spring.

For mole cricket control, apply whenever activity is observed. The best time to apply is in May or June.

HOW TO APPLY

Apply to dry foliage. Distribute over the entire turf area. Water after application to remove granules from the leaves.

For chinchbug control water sufficiently to carry material into the thatch layer of the turf.

For grub, mole cricket and billbug control water in thoroughly to carry the material into the soil.

PRECAUTIONS

As directed, water turf after application and allow to dry before permitting use of treated area.
