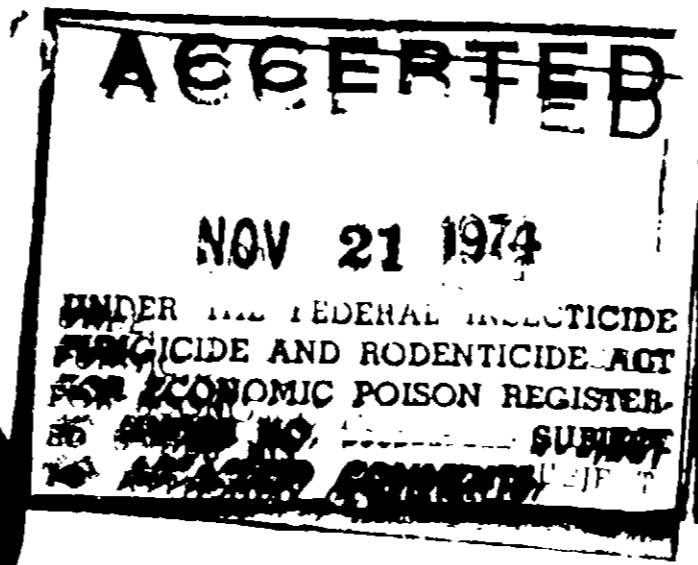

EASY TO USE!

When: Anytime blackspot, powdery mildew, aphids or spider mites are a problem on roses and flowers. Spray every five to seven days as needed.

Where: Spray upper and lower leaf surfaces and branches with a thin, uniform film.

How:

Hold 18" from foliage.

Spray with a slow sweeping motion.

For best results, spray when the air is still.

Excessive spraying may cause leaf discoloration.

Limitations:

- Do not use in the home

- When temperature exceeds 80°F, wait until evening to spray

- Do not spray when temperature exceeds 90°F.

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. May be absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Do not breathe spray, mist. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Do not use on household pets or humans. Keep out of reach of domestic animals. Do not contaminate fish ponds with spray or cleaning solution.

WARNING: Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.
