## Dear Ms. Kendrick:

The revised labeling referenced to above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended, is acceptable, provided you incorporate the Agency's conditions as enumerated in this letter below and submit one copy of your final printed label prior to releasing the product for shipment.

- 1). The sentence under Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals starting with "As directed, water lawn..." should be revised to read:
  - "As directed, water turf after application and allow to dry before permitting the public (especially children and pets) on treated areas."
- 2). The label must be revised to correct the typographical error in the following text "by cleaning off equipment" to read "by cleaning of equipment..."

Do not apply directly to water to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. ### Directions for Use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use a sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

### For use on turfgrass or dichondra

Controls chinch bugs and other insects listed below:

ant grasshopper
brown dog tick Hyperodes weevil
cricket sod webworm
cutworm (lawn moth larvae)
earwig vegetable weevil
flea beetle (in dichondra)

(in dochondra)

Apply over entire area. Overlap spreader wheel tracks so no strips are missed.

Water as recommended after each application to wash product particles into the zone of insect activity. Do not mow or collect clippings for 24 hours after treatment.

<u>CHINCH BUG control</u> – apply any time activity or damage is noticed. Water thoroughly (¼ to ½ inch) after each application.

<u>CHINCH BUG prevention</u> – apply as soon as daily temperatures reach 80° F or above and repeat at 2 month intervals. Water thoroughly (¼ to ½ inch) after each application.

<u>SOD WEBWORM, CUTWORM, EARWIG, FLEA BEETLE and VEGETABLE WEEVIL control</u> – apply whenever insect activity is suspected. Sprinkle lightly after application to remove product particles from the leaves.

ANT, TICK, CRICKET and GRASSHOPPER control – apply whenever insect activity is observed or suspected. Sprinkle lightly after each application to remove particles from leaves.

HYPERODES WEEVIL control – apply as soon as grass greens in the spring and repeat in one month. Water lightly after application.

Maximum application rate is 1lb chlorpyrifos per acre

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a clean, dry place. Reseal opened bag by folding top down and securing.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
