Apply any time weeds are actively growing. Do not apply when ground is frozen.

For bentgrass putting greens

For bentgrass putting greens apply at QUARTER RATE to moist foliage for control of clover and chickweed. Repeat treatment in 3 weeks if needed. (Treats 44,000 sq. ft.)

For use on other turfgrass areas

For turfgrass areas other than greens, apply to moist or dry foliage at—

HALF RATE to control clover (treats 22,000 sq. ft.)

NORMAL RATE to control knotweed, chickweed (common and mouse-ear), sheep sorrel and black medic (treats 11,000 sq. ft.)

DOUBLE RATE to control wild onion and garlic, curly dock, ground ivy, Canada thistle, cudweed, yarrow and horseweed. For control of yarrow and wild onion and garlic start treatments in either spring or fall and repeat at 6 month intervals for a total of 2 or 3 applications as needed (treats 5,500 sq. ft.)

Note

Avoid application on rootzone areas of trees and shrubs.

Do not apply when ground is frozen.

Delay planting grass seed until after a heavy rain or watering and not sooner than two weeks after treatment.

On new plantings delay treatment until after the second mowing.

Not for use on St. Augustinegrass or Dichondra.
