The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is accepted with the following provision:

1. Under "hazards to Human and Domestic Animals" revise the statement to read as follows:
  - a. Warning, causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Avoid contact with skin. Wear goggles or face shield. Harmful if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Avoid inhalation.
2. Make the following revisions to the "Statement of Practical Treatment:"
  - a. IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.
  - b. If ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.
  - c. IF SWALLOWED: Call a doctor or get medical attention. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Drink promptly a large quantity of milk, eggwhites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large of water. Avoid alcohol.

**Directions for use**

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

Apply any time weeds are actively growing. Do not apply when ground is frozen.

**For bentgrass putting greens**

For bentgrass putting greens apply at QUARTER RATE to moist foliage for control of clover and chickweed. Repeat treatment in 3 weeks if needed. (Treats 44,000 sq. ft.).

**For use on other turfgrass areas**

For turfgrass areas other than greens, apply to moist or dry foliage at--

HALF RATE to control clover (treats 22,000 sq. ft.).

NORMAL RATE to control knotweed, chickweed (common and mouse-ear), sheep sorrel and black medic (treats 11,000 sq. ft.).

DOUBLE RATE to control wild onion and garlic, curly dock, ground ivy, Canada thistle, cudweed, yarrow and horseweed. For control of yarrow and wild onion and garlic start treatments in either spring or fall and repeat at 6 month intervals for a total of 2 or 3 applications as needed (treats 5,500 sq. ft.).

#### Precautions

Avoid application on rootzone areas of trees and shrubs.

Do not apply when ground is frozen.

Delay planting grass seed until after a heavy rain or watering and not sooner than two weeks after treatment.

On new plantings delay treatment until after the second mowing.

Not for use on St. Augustinegrass or Dichondra.

Avoid application to garden plants, flowers, and rootzone areas.

For use on fine fescue or bentgrass turf maintained at a height of 1/2 inch or above, use at the HALF RATE or QUARTER RATE setting.

Do not apply to slopes next to lakes or waterways or on slopes above beds used for trees or ornamental plantings.

Do not apply this product to turf under stress from drought, insects, disease, cold temperatures, high temperatures of above 85°F on cool season grasses, or poor fertility, as injury may result.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

**STORAGE:** Store in a clean, dry place. Reseal opened bag by folding top down and securing.
