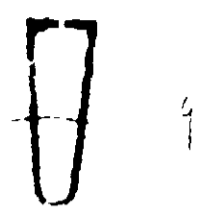

WINTER-SPRING PROGRAM — controls above weeds plus —

- prevents spotted spurge and crabgrass
- delays spring revival of bermudagrass
- controls vegetable weevil larvae

Apply in December, January or early February and repeat in 6 to 8 weeks. To prevent crabgrass and spurge both applications must be made before mid-March in Southern California, late March in the Interior Valley and before mid-April in Northern California.

FALL PROGRAM — to prevent Australian brass buttons, chickweed, foxtail barley, mallow, Poa annua and shepherds purse make an additional single application in September, October or early November.

To ensure proper distribution

Slightly overlap spreader wheel tracks to provide complete coverage.

PRECAUTIONS

Apply only to dry foliage. Important to rinse particles off leaves by adequate irrigation or hand hose spray immediately after application.

A new dichondra seeding can be treated with Super Bonus when the dichondra has covered the soil but no sooner than 2 months after seeding. Wait 4 weeks after sodding or plugging. After application delay planting of any dichondra for 8 weeks.

Avoid application on shaded area receiving less than 4 hours of sunlight daily.

Avoid application on shrubs, flowers, or vegetable plants.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 30.8 to 47.5 fluid ounces of SOLVENTOL SAN CLEAR per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning.
