

Directions for use

Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for reasearch purposes.

For use on turfgrass areas consisting of Kentucky bluegrass, annual bluegrass, bentgrass, perennial ryegrass, fine fescue, bermudagrass or mixtures where these grasses predominate.

TO PREVENT DOLLAR SPOT, ANTHRACNOSE AND RUST (Puccinia spp.), apply to moist or dry foliage at the RECOMMENDED RATE when environmental conditions favor disease activity. Repeat a two week intervals throughout the expected disease period. ✓

TO CONTROL ACTIVE DOLLAR SPOT, ANTHRACNOSE AND RUST (Puccinia spp.), apply at the DOUBLE RATE to moist or dry foliage at two week intervals. When the disease activity is under control, apply at the RECOMMENDED RATE at two week intervals.

TO PREVENT BROWN PATCH, apply to moist or dry foliage at the DOUBLE RATE when environmental conditions favor disease activity. Repeat at two week intervals throughout the expected disease period.

TO CONTROL ACTIVE BROWN PATCH, use a non-fertilizer fungicide such as ProTurf Fungicide 7 to limit the amount of fertilizer applied since high levels of nitrogen applied to turf during or just prior to the onset of hot, humid weather may increase the severity of brown patch. Follow with the RECOMMENDED RATE of either product once the disease is controlled.

Note carefully

To avoid product pickup lightly irrigate treated areas soon after application.

On short cut bentgrass (less than 3/4"), apply only to dry foliage when temperatures are above 80°F.

Storage and disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in a clean, dry place. Reseal opened bag by folding top down and securing. PROTECT FROM WATER AND EXTREME HEAT.
