Directions for use

Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

For use on turfgrass areas consisting of Kentucky bluegrass, annual bluegrass, bentgrass, perennial ryegrass, fine fescue, bermudagrass or mixtures where these grasses predominate.

TO PREVENT DOLLAR SPOT, ANTHRACNOSE AND RUST (*Puccinia* spp.) apply to moist or dry foliage at the RECOMMENDED RATE when environmental conditions favor disease activity. Repeat at 2 week intervals throughout the expected disease period.

TO CONTROL ACTIVE DOLLAR SPOT, ANTHRACNOSE AND RUST (*Puccinia* spp.) apply at the DOUBLE RATE to moist or dry foliage at 2 week intervals. When the disease activity is under control, apply at the RECOMMENDED RATE at two week intervals.

TO PREVENT BROWN PATCH apply to moist or dry foliage at the DOUBLE RATE when environmental conditions favor disease activity. Repeat at 2 week intervals throughout the expected disease period.

TO CONTROL ACTIVE BROWN PATCH use a non-fertilizer fungicide such as ProTurf Fungicide VII to limit the amount of fertilizer applied since high levels of nitrogen applied to turf during or just prior to the onset of hot, humid weather may increase the severity of brown patch. Follow with the RECOMMENDED RATE of either product once the disease is controlled.

Note carefully

To avoid product pick-up, lightly irrigate treated areas soon after application.

On short cut bentgrass (less than 3/4") when temperatures are above 80°F, apply only to dry foliage.
