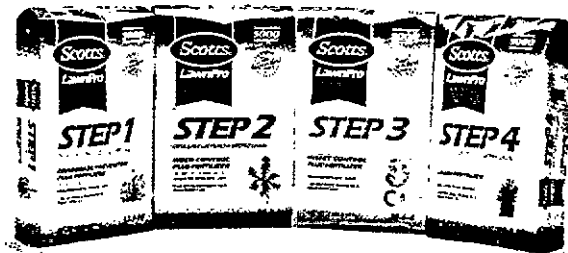

- Do not over apply, especially under the drip zone of desirable shrubs and trees as some of the control ingredients are root absorbers.
- Don't use on Bermuda, St. Augustinegrass, creeping bentgrass, bahia, or centipedegrass lawns or on newly seeded and sodded lawns until after the fourth mowing. Don't plant grass for one month after using this product and don't apply when daytime temperatures are consistently 90 degrees or above.
- Allow at least 48 hours between program applications.
- Watering or rain**
- Do not water your lawn for 24 hours after application. Water we wash the weed control off the weeds and reduce the effectiveness of this product.
- This product should not be applied if rain is expected within the next 24 hours.

- First apply 2 heaped spoons.
- Overlap spreader application area to avoid strips of untreated lawn.
- Shut off spreader when you reach the header strip or anyone you stop.

EasyGreen® Rotary

- Side shut-off lever to the right, application automatically starts and stops when you do
- Avoid mow by making each pass about 30 inches from the previous one to some overlapping occurs.

SpeedyGreen® Rotary

- Shut off spreader anytime you stop.
- Avoid mow by making each pass about 5 feet from the previous one to some overlapping occurs.

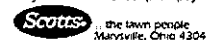
