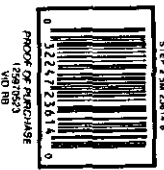

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. The product applies 1-3 pounds or 2-4 lb per acre per application. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is two per year.

- Application**
- Apply when weeds are actively growing, but not before yellow dandelion blooms have appeared.
 - Apply to most or dry foliage, however, for best results, apply in moist foliage.
 - Do not apply when applying the product near shrubs, flower beds or vegetable gardens as weed control may damage these ornamental plants.
 - Do not over apply, especially under the drip zone of available shrubs and trees at some of the control ingredients are not absorbed.
 - Do not use on clover, St. Augustine, creeping bermuda, bahia, or centipede grasses or on newly seeded and sodded lawns until after the fourth mowing. Don't plant grass for one month after using this product and don't apply when daytime temperatures are consistently 90 degrees or above.
 - Mow at least 4-6 weeks between program applications.

Watering or Rain

- Do not water your lawn for 24 hours after application. Water will wash the weed control off the weed leaves and reduce the effectiveness of the product.
- The product should not be applied if rain is expected within the next 24 hours.

Tips on Spreading

Scotts Drop:

- Do not apply during windy days.
- First apply 1/2 header strip.
- Overlap spreader application area to avoid strips of untreated lawn.
- Shut off spreader when you reach the header strip or any time you stop.

EasyGreens Rotary:

- 1. Set rate of lever to the right; application automatically starts and stops when you do.
- 2. Avoid ruts by making each pass about 30 inches from the previous one to some overlapping occurs.

SpeedyGreens Rotary:

- 1. Shut off spreader any time you stop.
- 2. Avoid ruts by making each pass about 5 feet from the previous one to some overlapping occurs.
