Ornamental Turfgrass Use

This product applies 1.5 pounds of 2,4-D, per acre per application. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is two per year.

Not for use on golf course putting greens. Fertilizes grass and controls these rosette and vine type weeds:

For use on ornamental Turfgrass areas other than putting greens.

Apply to moist foliage at the RECOMMENDED RATE or for better distribution when using a rotary spreader, apply at the HALF RATE/HALF WIDTH. Apply when weeds are growing actively. Grass should not be so tall it touches the bottom of the spreader. Rain, sprinkling, mowing, or heavy traffic within 24 hours after application can knock granules off weeds and may reduce effectiveness. Apply under non-windy conditions, thereby reducing drift to non-target areas, and optimizing particle distribution for good weed control. Retreating may be necessary, but wait at least 3 weeks to observe full results of first application.

Precautions

Avoid application when daytime temperatures are consistently 90 F or above.

Do not over apply, especially under the branch spread of trees and shrubs.

On new grass plantings delay application until after the fourth mowing.

Delay planting grass seed until after a heavy rain or watering and not sooner than 3 months after application.

Not for use on creeping bentgrass, St. Augustinegrass, carpetgrass, dichandra, ground covers, garden plants, flowers and shrubs.

Do not apply to centpedegrass turf in the spring before March 15 (or before the danger of frost has passed), or after September.

Do not apply to bahiagrass before March 15 or after November 1.

Storage and disposal

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
