DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Apply when insect activity is through normal or heavy grass growth in the lawn.
- Apply when lawn is dry.
- Water lawn after application, at least 10 minutes from the time of application. If watering for 10 minutes, water thoroughly so water penetrates soil to root zone. Do not water again until the next day.
- Do not water lawn to prevent further insect damage.
- Do not use on any other lawn treatment product for at least one week after application.
- A second application may be needed in 4 weeks if insect activity continues.
- Do not use on fruit or vegetable plants.

CRACK FUP LARVAE (grasshopper)
Apply when activity is low, resistant to the spray, usually mid-June to mid-Aug.
