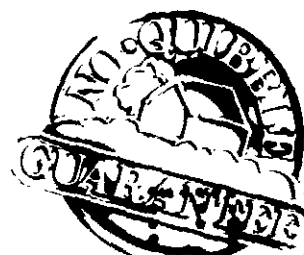

How much is enough?
To determine the square footage of your lawn, walk the length and width of your lawn; one average pace equals about 5 feet. Multiply the length of the lawn by the width of the lawn. This equals the area of your lawn in square feet. Note: If your lawn has an irregular shape, measure square areas, then add the figures together to reach your total lawn size.



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How and when to apply Apply in early spring.

Directions for use

This is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply when your lawn is dry. It is not necessary to water it in after application.

Apply in early spring before the first or all mowing or before spring rains are regular in the North. Rain, snow or freezing weather will not affect the performance of this product.

- For Kentucky Bluegrass, fine fescue, tall fescue, perennial ryegrass and blends of these grasses, apply at the **REGULAR RATE**.
- For Bermudagrass, St. Augustinegrass, bahiagrass, centipedegrass and blends of these grasses, apply at the **HEAVY RATE**.

Do not seed or sow for 4 months following application. The crabgrass barrier prevents grass seed from sprouting.

Apply to prevent germination of crabgrass (foxtail, bermudagrass, fall panicum, spurge) and quail, common velvet, seedling, etc. in early spring, before dandelions reach the puffball stage. Apply before March in southern California, and before mid-March in northern California.

For heavy infestations, a repeat treatment is recommended after 4 weeks.

Apply in August or September to prevent germination of Fall annuals and chickweed.

Not for use on declining or bentgrass lawns.

Use Scotts Halts® without fertilizer to prevent goosegrass.

Except for heavy infestations of spurge, allow at least a 4 month interval between applications of this product.

Do not apply Turf Builder Plus Halts® more than twice annually.

Important: Do not rake or aerify soil 4 months after application to avoid disturbing the crabgrass barrier on the soil surface.

Seeding, Sodding, Sprigging: Please do not apply to newly seeded or sodded areas until after the fourth mowing (the newly sprouted areas wait 5 months before application).

Staining Note: Can cause staining to cement, stone, metal surfaces, such as sidewalks and garden furniture, clothing or shoes. If contact occurs, brush off particles to prevent staining and/or repeated tracking into the house. If necessary, rinse off with water.

STORAGE: Store in a clean, dry place. Reveal opened container by folding top down and securing.

POTENTIAL DISPOSAL: Sewerage, wrap original container in newspaper or old newspaper and discard in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Discard in trash.

Spreading Tips

For best results, use a Scotts spreader

Scotts Drop: First apply two header strips. Overlap spreader application area to avoid strips of untreated lawn. Shut off spreader when you have reached the header strips or stopped.

EasyGreen® Rotary: Slide shut off lever to the right. Application automatically starts and stops when you do. Avoid messes by making each pass about 10 inches from the previous one so some overlapping occurs.

SpeedyGreen® Rotary: Shut off spreader as you turn the stop. Avoid messes by making each pass about 5 feet from the previous one so some overlapping occurs.
