

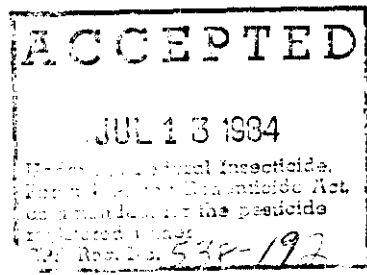

DO apply, to prevent germination of crabgrass, foxtail, spurge, barnyardgrass, fall panicum, goosegrass*, oxalis:

- . before March 1 in southern California. For best results on thin lawns apply by mid-February.
- . before mid-March in northern California.
- . early Spring (up to time dandelions are in puffball stage) in all other states.

* for goosegrass control, repeat application in 8 weeks.

Rain, snow or freezing weather after application will not affect the performance of this product.

DO apply in August or September to prevent germination of Poa annua and chickweed.
