APPLICATION

- . Apply any time weeds are actively growing (when daytime temperatures are consistently above 60°F).
- . Apply on a calm day.
- . Apply to moist grass. To help particles stick to weed leaves the grass should be thoroughly watered or wet from dew before applying Lawn Pro Weed and Feed.
- . Do not use this product on flowers, shrubs, fruit or vegetable plants or on creeping bentgrass, St. Augustine, lippia and dichondra lawns. On bermudagrass lawns, under certain conditions, some temporary discoloration may result.

WATERING OR RAIN

Do not water your lawn for 24 hours after application. Water will wash the weed control off the weed's leaves and reduce the effectiveness of this product.

This product should not be applied if rain is expected within the next 24 hours.

SPREADER

Be careful when applying this product near shrubs, flower beds or vegetable gardens as contact with weed control may damage these desirable plants. The Scotts PF Drop Spreaders provide excellent controlled application to protect these areas. When using the EasyGreen™ or SpeedyGreen™ Rotary Spreader take special care near desirable plants.

IMPORTANT

WHAT TO EXPECT

Weed stems and leaves will begin to twist and curl in a few days, but a month or more may be required for complete control.

This product will not prevent weed seeds from producing new plants.

EXTREME TEMPERATURES

Avoid applying when temperatures are consistently above 90 degrees.

SEEDING/SODDING

Wait until the new grass has been mowed at least four times before applying Lawn Pro Weed and Feed weed control.

If you are planning to seed, sod, or sprig you should wait at least one month after you have applied Lawn Pro Weed and Feed.

TIPS ON SPREADING WITH SCOTTS SPREADERS

Scotts Drop:

- First apply 2 header strips
- Operate spreader the longest way of the lawn (ILLUS.)
- Overlap wheels to insure uniform feeding
- Shut off spreader when you have reached the header strips or stopped (ILLUS.)
- Mow lawn first if grass is tall enough to touch the bottom of spreader

EasyGreen™ Rotary:

- Slide shut-off lever to the right. Application automatically starts and stops when you do
- For complete coverage make each pass about 30 inches from the previous one so some overlapping occurs

Speedy Green™ Rotary:

- Shut off spreader anytime you stop
- For complete coverage make each pass about 5 feet from the previous one so some overlapping occurs
- Avoid applying product in flower beds adjacent to lawns.
