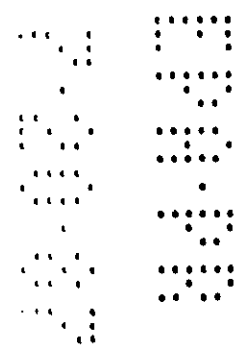

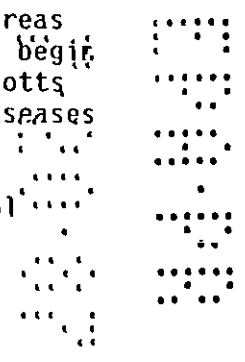
Directions for use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- Apply to any type of lawn
- Apply 1/2" of water after application to activate the fungicide. Continue to supply 1" of water per week during hot, dry weather.
- To control leaf spot, melting-out, dollar spot, pink patch (red thread), brown patch, (and Fusarium patch in California, Oregon, and Washington). Apply at the REGULAR RATE (5,000 sq ft coverage). You may reapply at two to three week intervals if weather conditions DO NOT change and disease activity continues. To control severe disease infestations, apply at the DOUBLE RATE and repeat monthly.
- To prevent and suppress summer patch diseases (also known as Fusarium blight, Fusarium roseum, frog-eye, and necrotic ring spot). Apply at the DOUBLE RATE (2,500 sq ft coverage). You may re-apply at monthly intervals if weather conditions DO NOT change and disease activity continues.

Summer patch symptoms return annually to the same lawn areas when hot, dry weather promotes stress. For best results begin preventive applications in late spring-early summer. Scotts Play(R) Lawn Seed will offer some resistance to these diseases if lawn renovation becomes necessary.

- Allow one week between the application of this and any other control product.

TIPS ON SPREADING WITH SCOTTS SPREADERS

Scotts Drop:

- First apply two header strips
- Operate spreader the longest way of the lawn
- Overlap wheels to insure complete disease control
- Shut off spreader when you have reached the header strips or anytime you stop
- Mow lawn first if grass is tall enough to touch the bottom of spreader

EasyGreen™ Rotary:

- Slide shut-off lever to the right. Application automatically starts and stops when you do
- Avoid misses by making each pass about 30 inches from the previous one so some overlapping occurs

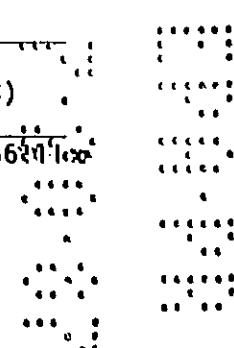
