Subject: Amendment - Label changes required by Reg Stds for Phenoxy Active Ingredients Private Label Weed and Feed EPA Reg. No. 538-220 Your Submission Dated May 15, 1990

The labeling amendment referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that the following changes are made:

- Page 1: Change "Augsutine" to "Augustine". Under "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals", change Avoid contact with "eyes or clothing" to "eyes, skin or clothing".
- Page 8: Change "use" to "us" evidence and this "products" to "product".

Also, we note that the values for net weight and guaranteed analysis are blank. Please use the appropriate container disposal statement for this product. Also, provide a range for the ingredients listed under Guaranteed Analysis.

Please submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling incorporating the amendment before you release the product for shipment. A stamped copy of your draft label is enclosed for your records.

APPLICATION

- . Apply anytime weeds are actively growing (when daytime temperatures are consistently above 60°).
- . Apply on a calm day.
- . Apply to moist grass. To help particles stick to weed leaves the grass should be thoroughly watered or wet from dew before applying Private Label Weed and Feed.
- . On bahia and centipede lawns, wait until after the second mowing of the year but NOT before mid-March. In the Fall, do NOT treat centipede after the first of October and DO NOT treat bahia after the first of november.
- . Do not use this product on flowers, shrubs, fruit or vegetable plants or on creeping bentgrass, St. Augustine and dichondra lawns. On bermudagrass lawns, under certain conditions, some temporary discoloration may result.

WATERING OR RAIN

Do not water your lawn for 24 hours after application. Water will wash the weed control off the weed's leaves and reduce the effectiveness of this product.
