ADDENDUM:

(CONSUMER, HOSE-END LIQUID)

For liquid products registered for use on residential and other turf sites (excluding sod farms) the following statements have been added to the <u>Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals</u> section of the label.

"Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment areas during application. Do not enter treatment areas until spray has dried or dust has settled."
