EPA Registration No. 538-231
Application Dated March 30, 1993 Requesting
an Additional Brand Name and Label Amendment

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provisions:

- 1) Under the Isomer Specific by ACAC method section, correct the spelling of the chemical 2-(2-Methyl-4-Chlorophenoxy).
- 2) There are two different reentry statements on the label. If you choose to keep the two statements on the label, the reentry statement under the Environmental Hazards section must be consistent with the reentry statement within the Precautionary Statements. The reentry statement should read as follows:

"Do not allow people (other than the applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until spray has dried or dust has settled."

Alternatively, the reentry statement under the Environmental Hazards section may be deleted, since the statement is not required to appear twice on the label.

6. When ready to spray, point nozzle toward lawn, then turn ON/OFF lever to ON position.
7. When finished, turn ON/OFF lever to OFF and turn off faucet. Turn ON/OFF lever to ON to release water pressure, then turn OFF again.
8. Remove nozzle from bottle, then replace cap for storage.

Directions for use

When to use

- o This product applies 0.87 pounds of 2,4-D per acre per application. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is two per year.
- o Use whenever broadleaf weeds such as dandelions, clover, plantain and chickweed are actively growing.
- o Apply beginning in spring, after your second mowing, anytime through the fall. Some hard-to-control broadleaf weeds may require a second treatment in 3 to 4 weeks.
- o Regular lawn watering is necessary to maintain a quality lawn. During periods of drought or hot, dry weather (exceeding 85°F), do not use this product until the rains occur or the lawn is watered.

- o Apply on a calm day to avoid spray drift to non-target plants.
- o Wait until you mow three or four times before you use this product on new grass.
- o Delay planting grass seed, sodding, or sprigging until after a heavy rain or watering and not sooner than 3 to 4 weeks after treatment.

How to use

- o Begin spraying at a point furthest from the faucet, holding the product in front of you at waist height. Use a side-to-side swinging motion to cover an 8- to 10-foot swath. Overlap swaths by at least one foot to ensure even coverage.
- o Do not water your lawn until 48 hours have passed since treatment. This product should not be applied if rain is expected within 48 hours.
- o Avoid applications near shrubs, flowers, fruit, or vegetable plants, as plant injury may occur.
- o Not for use on creeping bentgrass, St. Augustinegrass, carpetgrass, dichondra, lippia or similar ground covers.
