Changes

The amended label for EPA Reg. No.: 538-234 / Weed Control with Fertilizer is acceptable provided you make the following changes to the label:

1. To "If in Eyes..., If on Skin or Clothing..., If Swallowed..., and If Inhaled..." add "Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.". The First Aid section should be placed within a box. The First Aid and Precautionary Statements must be moved to the front of the label to follow after the ingredients statements section.
2. The Hazards to Human and Domestic Animals section must be changed to "Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Wear long sleeved shirt and long pants, socks, and shoes."
3. Insert the correct amount into Treats X,XXX Sq. Ft.
4. On page 3 change "Do not apply by hand. Hand-held..." to "Do not apply granular lawn products by hand. Avoid contact with hands or skin." "Broadcast applications must NOT be made using hand-held devices, such as a belly grinder or handheld rotary applicator. Such equipment may only be used for spot treatments."
5. To Optional Directions for Use remove "This product must be watered...", "Do not apply this product in a way...", "Do not allow people...", and "Do not apply by hand. Hand...". These statements are required under the Directions for Use.
6. To the Directions for Use add "Maximum rate per application turfgrass (including lawns) is [registrant insert the maximum rate of the formulated product per unit area – such as 4 lbs. per ,000 square feet – that reflects a maximum application rate of 2 pound active ingredient per acre]." "Maximum of two applications per year."
7. To the Storage and Disposal section change "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage" and



"Disposal" to "Pesticide Disposal".

8. To Notice change "Buyer assumes all risk..." to "To the extent consistent with applicable law, buyer assumes all risk...".

Amended labeling will supercede all previous accepted ones. A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. If you have any questions please call Erik Kraft at 703-308-9358.


